Dear parent/carer

Concerns have been raised about inconsiderate and dangerous driving and parking around the Academy during peak times. There have been reports of 'near misses' at the parental drop-off point at the front of the Academy and in the parent car park opposite the Academy cycle-path.

As I'm sure you will appreciate the safety of our students is paramount and therefore I request help to minimize the risk to all and ease the disruption. All those driving onto the Academy site and using residential roads surrounding the Academy should behave legally ensuring the following:

- Observe all of the one way systems, entrances and exits
- Do not park on yellow lines, zig-zags or bays designated for buses
- Avoid parking in prohibited places
- Refrain from stopping in the middle of the road to drop off or pick up your child, even for a few seconds.

I'm aware that the vast majority drive and park appropriately. Thank you in advance for your support in this important matter. Let's ensure the safety of our students and be more considerate.
