Results Day

Results day will be **Thursday 25 August 2022** and students can collect their statement of results from the Main Hall between **10.00am** and **12.00pm**. Please arrive through Reception.

Students who are unable to collect their results can nominate a friend or family member to collect them on their behalf. A signed letter from the student confirming that they give permission must be provided and the nominated person must bring a form of photo identification with them. The results will not be released without these things in place. No results will be given out by telephone or email under any circumstances.

Lunch Accounts

Students who have exceeded the funds in their lunch accounts need to 'clear' any outstanding lunchtime debts via the iPay System, www.ipayimpact.co.uk. Please take an opportunity to log into your child's iPay account and check their final balance. In order to login to the iPay impact website you must have a registered account. Obviously the above study sessions are to fully prepare all of our students for their examinations.

Students who are arriving into the Academy, for any reason, are expected to be in full school uniform. During all days, a study room will be available for students who require it. This will be supervised by staff.

Any students who are NOT fully engaging with these sessions, will be asked to complete self study from home.

Students who are on free school meals will be able to access a lunch from the kitchen before they leave the school site.
