Uniform:

As parents and carers approach the summer, when families usually buy and replace uniform, please can we provide a reminder of uniform expectations:

- Plain black shoes (must be polishable) – no trainers, boots, pumps or canvas shoes will be allowed
- Socks/tights- they must be plain black
- Jewellery- No jewellery is allowed except a wrist watch and a Medic Alert necklace or bracelet. Smart watches are not allowed in the Academy. No rings or ear piercings
- Outwood tie- must be worn at all times
- Bag- all students need a bag that can fit in a planner and an A4 workbook. All students must have their planner with them.
- Hair colour- must be a natural hair colour
- Nail polish and any type of false nails (including clear gels, acrylics, extensions, etc) are not allowed.
- No hoodies, coats or jackets to be worn inside school

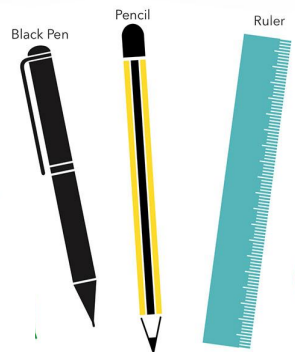

Equipment:

Being equipped is the key to success at school and in preparation for the new term, the basic expectations that all students should arrive to school with, every day, are:

- A planner - which is provided by the Academy and students will receive this in September.
- A pen
- A pencil
- A ruler
- A bag - that can fit their planner, pencil case and an A4 workbook.

Pupils **must** also bring a suitable bag to school everyday to carry their equipment, planner and text books.

Lateness:

We want all of our students to be punctual to the Academy to avoid missing learning time.

If a student arrives 5 minutes late on a daily basis, that results in 3 days of learning lost in the academic year.

If a student arrives 30 minutes late on a daily basis, that results in 19 days of learning lost in the academic year.

From September the time a student will be recorded as 'late to school' will change, due to a change in DFE guidance. All registers must now close 30 minutes after they open, ours will therefore close at 8:50am and anyone signed into school after this point will be classified as 'late to school.'

At 90% you have missed almost 100 lessons in a year. Attendance at 90% each year means that by Year 11, you will have missed out on 6 months of learning.

92% equals 3 weeks of lost learning every year. Between Year 7 and Year 11, this means 15 weeks lost in total.

≥93%

95% means a half-day missed every 2 weeks. In a year, that's 43 lessons to catch up on.

School Lunch Prices:

From September, there will be a slight Increase in lunch charges, with a main meal moving to £1.75 and a meal deal (meal and a drink OR dessert) moving to £2.25.

We have maintained current prices for a significant period of time, however, the cost of providing school lunches in the current climate is ever increasing.

For those who receive free school meals the amount credited to your child's account will be adjusted accordingly.
