**Transition Events** 

At this stage, I would like to draw your attention to our **Y6 Meet the Tutor evening** and **Transition Induction Days** for new students.

The Y6 Meet the Tutor evening will take place on Monday 3 July 2023 at 4:30pm – 6:00pm.

The Transition Induction days have been rescheduled to comply with all schools in our area and will now take place on Tuesday I.I. July 2023 and Wednesday I.2 July 2023. Year 6 students will

spend time with their peers and tutors, as well as experiencing exciting and engaging lessons

throughout the Academy.

Lunch will be provided, free of charge. Students are also welcome to bring a packed lunch if they

wish.

We ask that Students arrive at 8:00am via Gate I which is located at the front of the Academy.

This will be sign posted and staff will be on hand to assist you.

Year 6 students should make their own way to and from the Academy on Transition Induction Days,

please make arrangements for your child to travel safely. Unfortunately the Academy does not run a

bus service for students, however students who require these bus routes are covered by Stagecoach

buses. Timetables are available on the Stagecoach website - www.stagecoachbus.com.

All Year 6 students will be dismissed from school at 2.00pm. Staff will be present to

assist you.

Please be aware that there are 270 Year 6 students joining us for the transition days and we have

very limited parking and drop off spaces available however, there is a car park to the left when you

come into the school site which can be used.

Parents / Carers are welcome to make their way to the Theatre where they can meet students, wait

at the carpark or at the end of the Academy drive where students will be escorted to, or allow

students to make their own way home. Students travelling home with a friend or sibling who already

attends Outwood Academy Acklam, will be supervised whilst they wait until 2:30pm in the Theatre.
