This is one of the most important events of the year for all students in Year 11 as the evening will include the following:

- Information on how you can support your son/daughter this year
- An information booklet with key subject information, revision strategies, the **November mock timetable** and the exam board provisional GCSE summer timetable of exams
- Guidance and short sessions on effective revision strategies your son/daughter should be using
- Revision materials for use over half term to support students in their half term revision in preparation for the November mocks

- Praising Stars Data - your first chance to find out about effort and projected grades for your son/daughter
